independent work of a student in the discipline "Obstetrics"

Topic: Anomalies in the development of the fertilized egg. Multiple pregnancy

Number of hours - 3.

Purpose: to study the concept of "multiple pregnancy", the causes of multiple births, different options for the development of multiple births (classification), features of pregnancy and possible complications of multiple births, methods of diagnosing multiple pregnancies, features of pregnancy and childbirth with multiple births.

The student must: diagnose multiple pregnancies, develop tactics for multiple pregnancies and birth control, determine the position of the fetus in the uterine cavity.

Class organization:

III. Practical experience:

1. Examination of pregnant women with multiple births, history taking, assessment of risk factors for complications during pregnancy, childbirth and in the early postpartum period.

2. Carrying out auscultation of fetus.

3. Practice of external obstetric examination to determine the position, type, position of the fetus.

4. Performing the stages of the operation of the classic external-internal (combined) rotation of the fetus and pulling the fetus by the leg on the phantom.

IV. Solving situational problems.

Tasks for self-training and self-correction of the initial level of skills

1. When the mother enters the maternity hospital, multiple births are established. Pregnancy is full-term, pelvis is normal, labor is active, both fetuses are in the main presentation, her condition is satisfactory. Determine the tactics of childbirth?

Answer: Childbirth should be performed conservatively through the natural birth canal.

2. Pregnant 23 years, pregnancy 18 weeks, second. The first pregnancy ended in a premature birth, the child died on the 5th day from a congenital kidney defect (which the pregnant woman does not know for sure). Examination revealed that the volume of the uterus is much smaller than the gestational age, according to a previous ultrasound examination of IAR less than 4 cm. What pathology of pregnancy can be thought of. What additional measures should be taken?

Answer: A pregnant woman has moderate dehydration. To rule out congenital kidney disease, a consultation with a medical and genetic center is required.

3. After a viral infection in a pregnant woman at 25 weeks of gestation, a rapid enlargement of the uterus was detected. Pregnant woman indicates general malaise, abdominal pain, edema. Objectively increased relative to the gestational age of the uterus, positive symptoms of fluctuations and running, tension of the uterine wall, unstable position of the fetus. What is the preliminary diagnosis?

A. Multiple pregnancy.

B. Polyhydramnios.
