Task 5

Multi para 36 years old was admitted to the hospital at the first stage of childbirth with reductions in average strength by 30-35 seconds after 2-3 minutes. This is the fifth pregnancy. The history had one normal birth, two abortions, and the last pregnancy four years ago ended with a cesarean section due to the disproportion of cephalopelvicum. In the midst of one of the contractions, the woman in labor complained of "dagger" abdominal pain, weakness. BP 70/40 mm Hg, fetal heartbeat is absent. The abdomen on palpation is intense, sharply painful. The contours of the uterus are blurred.
