## Task 6

In a 24-year-old postpartum woman, on the 5th day after giving birth, her body temperature suddenly increased. Complains of weakness, headache, pain in the lower abdomen, irritability. Objectively: BP 120/70 mm Hg, pulse - 92 beats/ min, body temperature - 38.7 ° C. Bimanual examination: the uterus is enlarged as in a 12-week pregnancy, soft, painful on palpation, the cervical canal passes 2 fingers (3 cm). The vaginal discharge is bloody, cloudy, with an unpleasant odor. In the blood: white blood cells  $12x10^{9}/1$ , neutrophilic shift, lymphopenia, ESR - 30 mm / hour.

1. Interpretation of objective / laboratory data.

2. The formulation of the preliminary diagnosis based on the identification of pathological changes.

3. The appointment of additional examination methods (laboratory or instrumental) to confirm the diagnosis.

4. Definition of the basic principles of treatment (medication or surgical) of this pathology.
